Overall purpose

- 1 To maintain and develop provision in the Think! strand of SparkFish work, providing opportunities for spiritual and moral development in local schools by arranging Think! spaces.
- 2 To contribute to the Hope strand of SparkFish work, supporting nominated pupils at Furzefield Primary School

Develop this strand of SparkFish work	 Liaise with local schools to arrange a manageable annual programme Develop a team to staff Think! spaces, set them up and take them down. Keep an inventory of Think! resources in our Think! storage space Keep records of Think! spaces and develop new stations for future use. Maintain and develop links with Prayer Spaces in Schools / other relevant networks (www.prayerspacesinschools.com) 	
Plan visits to particular schools	 Liaise with school to discuss theme. Plan Think! space and send draft plan to school. Order and gather resources required. Confirm Think! week rota for pupils with school. Organise team for leadership, transport, set up and take down.

Co-ordinator for THINK!

This role has a **Genuine Occupational Requirement** to be filled by a committed Christian.

The post involves leadership of the ministry of SparkFish which makes the Christian faith accessible to young people and includes opportunities for them to develop their own Christian faith.

The person filling this role will need to be a committed Christian as they will have responsibility for:

- > Representing and explaining the Christian aims and values of SparkFish.
- Developing activities which will give young people an opportunity to understand and access the Christian faith
- Evaluating the suitability of volunteers to serve in a Christian organisation and providing spiritual leadership in the area of schools ministry.
- Working with churches and Christian agencies to establish mutually effective ministry partnerships.

SparkFish has an emphasis on continuous professional development for its employees. The CPD for this role may include training in Christian ministry and personal spiritual development.
